Since most of the events in the calendar have been upended in one way or another, I encourage you to check their status on their respective websites.

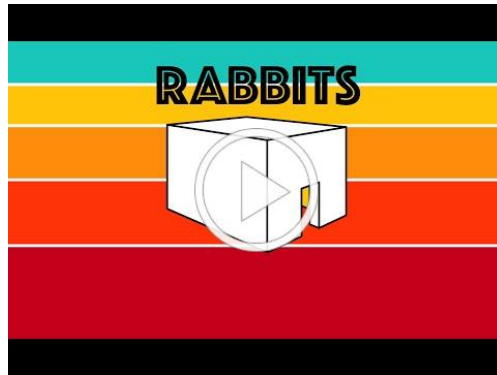
